THIS PUBLIC HEARING IS CALLED TO DISCUSS THE 2020/2021 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET

Clerk Burrell and President Farber reviewed the proposed budget. President Farber said that the following items are included in the budget, but the Village Council will have the final say on each project as they arise. Clerk Burrell talked about the following items in the proposed budget: computer upgrades, camera system for Weaver Pavilion park, increasing the budget for legal counsel, including funds for election year, sidewalk and street repairs for major streets, street repairs and overlay for multiple local streets, tasers and in car cameras for the police department, new pumps for sewer site, new roof for building at sewer site, 3% raise increase for village employees and repairs to the County garage door and painting of the DPW building.

- Sara Walker asked if the additional amount budgeted for Legal Counsel was for a retainer. President Farber explained that we did not have a retainer and we were billed for hours used. Chief Herremans mentioned that there was \$2,000 in the budget to enforce ordinances.

President Farber asked if anyone had any questions. No one had any questions.
