ProMed began serving the Community 17 years ago. ProMed knew at that time, there was not going to be enough revenue but took us on anyway. ProMed is still in business in Muskegon, we are not their priority. They are losing \$200,000 annually. Council adopted two (2) Resolutions (Attached) to be sent to Newaygo and Oceana County Board Chairmans hoping to find a solution.
