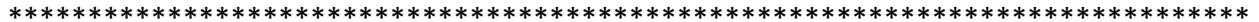




PUBLIC HEARING

Clerk Miller and President Farber reviewed the proposed budget with a few additions; such as adding Blight and Dam Repair, also an increase in the Police Department possibly adding an additional full time police officer.

Eileen Nelson asked if there is money in the budget for street repair on Alpha, President Farber stated there is money in the local and major street funds for pot hole repair and other maintenance issues.

Joyce McDonald announced that MDOT (Michigan Department of Transportation) has put out a notice that municipalities will be receiving a little extra money this year, Treasurer Burrell stated the amount is about \$9,500.

Eileen Nelson inquired as to who mows the ball field next to hers, if we do it? Council thought the Catholic Church maintains it.

Council member Raymond asked the audience if they had any questions or the other Council members?
