Special Council Meeting
June 15, 2018

Call to Order: President Farber called this Special Council Meeting to order at 9:00 AM in the Village Hall. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call was taken with a quorum noted.

Also present: Treasurer Burrell, Interim Chief Bob Farber

This meeting was called to order to discuss Chief of Police Salary and Life Insurance

Motion by McDonald **Seconded** by Biggart (motion CARRIED)

A motion was made to offer Joseph FitzGerald an annual salary of \$55,000 per year, a 5 year contract, to offer health insurance for himself, 1 week of sick leave upon first day if employment, 1 week vacation upon hire with the ability to comp 40 hours toward vacation. After 6 months of his start date, he will receive 2 weeks of vacation instead of 1 week. At annual anniversary date, he will receive 3 weeks vacation with the ability to comp 40 hours toward vacation and one personal day. He also was appointed as Zoning Administrator for \$2,000 per year.

Discussion:

Joseph FitzGerald's start date would be July 2, 2018 with an annual salary of \$55,000 per year, It was agreed that the Village of Hesperia would provide two summer uniforms and two winter uniforms. Joe FitzGerald would purchase his utility belt. If he lives within 5 miles of village, he can take the police cruiser home. If not, he will have to drive his personal vehicle. He would receive a review in 90 days and an annual review in November of each year.
