Announcements/Correspondence: President Farber gave an update on the COVD-19 situation. Governor Whitmer's Executive Order runs through the 28th of May. Councilperson McDonald discussed an e-mail that was sent by Jayne Biggart regarding still wanting to have a parade for the 4th of July after the Hesperia Fun Fest event was cancelled by the Hesperia Area Chamber of Commerce. Councilperson McDonald recommended that Ms. Biggart contact Scott Rumsey from the Chamber of Commerce with her request since they organize that event.

Police Department: President Farber asked if police hours could be increased to 5 days per week. Chief Herremans said that yes, but it may not be every week.

DPW Report: President Farber said that they are still pumping out at the sewer site. Brian Minor from M.R.W.A. expects the pumping to be complete near the end of May. President Farber reported that Randy Phillips, our temporary O.I.C. of our water system, will be working with Missions to get all alerts hooked up correctly. President Farber will be working with Randy Phillips on a leak on State Street. The village is planning on flushing the hydrants closer to the end of Mya. The parks are cleaned and mowing has commenced for the season. We received the results of the quarterly PFAS testing. At this time, no action is required since we are under 75 PPT.
